**SUBJECT:** Approval to Purchase the Philips MRI Safe Patient Monitor

I am requesting approval to purchase a Philips MRI Safe Patient Monitor that will be utilized in the Mobile MRI unit. Currently, when a patient needs to be transported to MRI across the street at the 2500 building, the nurses need to unplug the patient from the Philips monitor, and connect them to the monitor that Royal Ambulance carries. The nurses also have long tubing for the pumps, which stay outside the MRI, but are long enough to have the patient scanned. Our original plan was to have the patients convert to the wireless monitor we currently use, just like we would when a patient gets scanned in CT, and purchase cables long enough to have the monitor outside the room. In discussions with the Philips sales representative to inquire about longer cables, it was discovered that Philips does not make longer cables, and the cables that are used for the wireless monitor are not MRI compatible.

We will need to purchase an MRI Safe Patient Monitor from Philips. The total cost, including sales tax and shipping, is \$86,756. We will not have the unit here in time when the MRI machine arrives on November 11. The Philips sales representative would be providing us with a loner, with all the accessories (cables, EKG pads, etc.), until we are able to get our own unit.

It is requested that the Board of Directors authorize the Chief Executive Officer to proceed with the purchase of the Phillips MRI Safe Patient Monitor, not to exceed \$86,756, including sales tax and shipping. This was not included in the Fiscal Year 25 capital budget. Contingency capital budget funds will be used for this purchase.
