The **38th Annual Top Hat Gala**, which took place on Saturday, October 12, was a huge success! Donations totaled more than \$1,005,000 in gross revenue. The Foundation extends a sincere thank you to the sponsors and all those who attended Top Hat, with proceeds benefiting a new MRI for Washington Hospital.

As Washington Hospital continues to grow, and with the opening of the new Level II Trauma Center, the Hospital is in need of its own MRI. The **3 Tesla wide-bore MRI** is an ultra-high resolution imaging device that will significantly improve patient outcomes



and enable more detailed readings, which can lead to earlier and more accurate diagnoses. It will also allow us to offer new procedures locally that patients previously had to leave the community to receive.

The night of the gala, guests enjoyed beautiful fall weather in the outdoor Italian-themed garden area, before entering the grand tent, which included a fabulous meal, a wonderful performance by Italian tenor, Pasquale Esposito, and a high-energy auction. The night continued until midnight with dancing, cocktails, coffee and desserts fireside.
